

The Lamb's Book of LIFE

Revelation 21:27 indicates that, while every name in humanity's vast population has the potential to be written in the Lamb's Book of Life, nothing unclean or detestable will ever enter the purity of God's eternity. Only the Names declared blameless, though we are never faultless, become worthy.

Revelation 20:12 tells us: *"I saw the dead, both the important and unimportant standing in front of the Great White Throne, and books were open to pass judgment on the actions, choices and behavior of those who have passed."* So, what about these other books filled with actions, choices and behavior, Satan's Library?

Way too many, even some we would call good folks perhaps, after having an emotional experience declaring Christ as Savior and Lord, revert back into the trap of losing faith in the providence of "grace." They begin relying on the perception that behavior or works will be the provisional passage to their heavenly eternity. This is sad!!! Of the seven judgments mentioned in Scripture, only two really matter to us. First, the Lamb's Book of LIFE, our eternal destination --- makes the cut.

Now, by all means, we want to avoid that second one, the Great White Throne Judgment. So, if grace is not your absolute right of passage beyond a shadow of doubt when the time comes, your name will not appear in the Lamb's Book of Life. So, If you were to pass into eternity while reading this BIAP, is it possible that your perception of security might rely too much on those other books filed under your name? Perhaps in one or more of the following:

The Book of LAW (Have you always absolutely followed the law in every situation?)

1 John 1:10 tells us we all sin. If we say we don't, we accuse God of being a liar. Romans 14:23 reminds us, whatever is not inspired by faith is sin.

The book of SECRETS (Have you ever held a secret inappropriately?)

Luke 8:17 tells us there is nothing hidden that will not be revealed, and there is no secret that will not come into light. Have you ever stated one thing to one person and another to a second person?

The Book of WORDS (Have you ever spoken inappropriately?)

Matthew 12:36-37 reminds us that we will give account of every thoughtless word we've ever uttered; by our words we will be acquitted or condemned.

Proverbs 18:21 reminds us that life and death are in the power of the tongue.

The Book of CONSCIENCE (Have you ever gone against what was right?)

Romans 2:15 reminds us, the LAW is written on our hearts. Our consciences will either accuse or excuse our choices. Following our conscience though is not always the same as seeking our Lord's wisdom and counsel. Be cautious, our conscience may be influenced by momentary emotions and our environmental teaching.

The Book of PRIDE (Have you ever feared for the need to boast your image?)

Remember, pride may be a cover-up for fear. It comes before the fall.

THE LAMB'S BOOK OF LIFE is the only Book needed to avoid Satan's library! The RESURRECTION of the CHRIST defeated Satan's fear driven dominion. It is the only key to eternity with our LORD
